You must be at least 18 years old, read and speak English, and have a Facebook account to participate in this study. If you meet the above criteria, you may begin the game or contact us, using the contact information provided below, if you have any questions or experience any issues.

Getting Started

If you decide you want to be part of this study, simply click the *Funhouse* link at <http://isensorlab.com/> and follow the instructions. The game works best in Mozilla Firefox browsers. You must also disable you secure browsing setting within Facebook. By default this setting is set to off, but make sure to check it so that the game will work. To do this, click on the downward arrow on the top right hand menu, select "Account Setting," then choose "Security" from the left hand sidebar menu, and then disable "Secure Browsing" by unchecking the box and clicking "Save Changes." Once you are ready, you can get back to the game through the above link.
